Six seniors earn city scholarships

Six Brighton High School seniors received college scholarships Thursday through the city's Youth in Government program.

The six received their awards at a recognition dinner, attended by more than 50 people, at the Brighton Senior Center.

Recipients and their scholarships were: Breann Fuller, \$1,500 academic; Danielle Chaplin, \$1,000 academic; Akeelah Harrell, \$1,500 career advancement; Hannah Vaughn, \$1,150 career advancement; Yazmin Torres, \$1,000 career advancement; and Yesenia Gonzalez, \$1,000 overall improvement.

All six students participated in a monthlong program, during which they shadowed City Council members, city staffers or Fire District staff members to learn the operations and functions of city government.

Students wrote essays and were interviewed to earn their scholarships, said a city news release.
